The Bannerman Shield is one of the oldest trophies in the club, being presented to the club in 1898 by A.G. Bannerman to be used for annual competition. The shield is highly detailed and features Lochfauld School, The Burgh of Maryhill Coat of Arms plus the Maryhill Harriers crest. A.G. Bannerman was one of the club's early Patrons (listed as a Patron in a club membership booklet from 1919) and an Honorary Life Member. The shield was re-plated in 1998 in the original workshop, where the importance of the piece (representing an art now lost) was noted.

The shield was initially awarded to the winning intra-club team over a 7 mile cross country route - the first three men to finish in the winning team had their names engraved on the shield with the captain of the winning team holding the shield for one year. During the 1980s and 1990s the Bannerman Team Race was a blind ballot (based on form) race for teams of four, hence not an individual winner in the current era. Only after the race did harriers discover which team they were in and which team was the winner.

In recent years the shield has inspired a new generation of competition within the club. This has taken the form of the Bannerman Relay Races where seniors and juniors race together in a relay format. Each team consists of one senior and three juniors, all racing on the local Caldercuilt running track. Seniors complete 4 laps (1 mile) and juniors compete 1-2 laps (depending on age). The Bannerman shield was awarded to the senior harrier who ran the fastest mile.

The shield was retired in 2016 after it was decided that (from 2017) there should be separate men's and women's trophies for the revised Bannerman Race, contested by senior harriers. This now takes the form of a trail race held annually in Dawsholm Park.
