



Maryhill Harrier of the Year – Tom Blakely Cup

This trophy dates back to 1932 when it was presented by Maryhill Harriers to Tom Blakely (1904-1980) in recognition of breaking the 3 miles Scottish Record and winning the 4 miles S.A.A.A. Championship, both in 1932. Blakely went on to break his own 3 miles record in 1933 and over his career was successful both individually and as part of the strong Maryhill Harrier teams which took medals and titles in the National cross country championships, Edinburgh-to-Glasgow road relays and West & Midlands cross country relays.

The cup is now awarded to the Maryhill Harrier of the Year and is an annual presentation - each senior club member votes for the harrier they feel is deserving of the title. This could envelope various parameters such as running performance and improvement throughout the year, dedication to and support of the club, coaching and ambassadorial roles for the club within **scottish**athletics and beyond.
